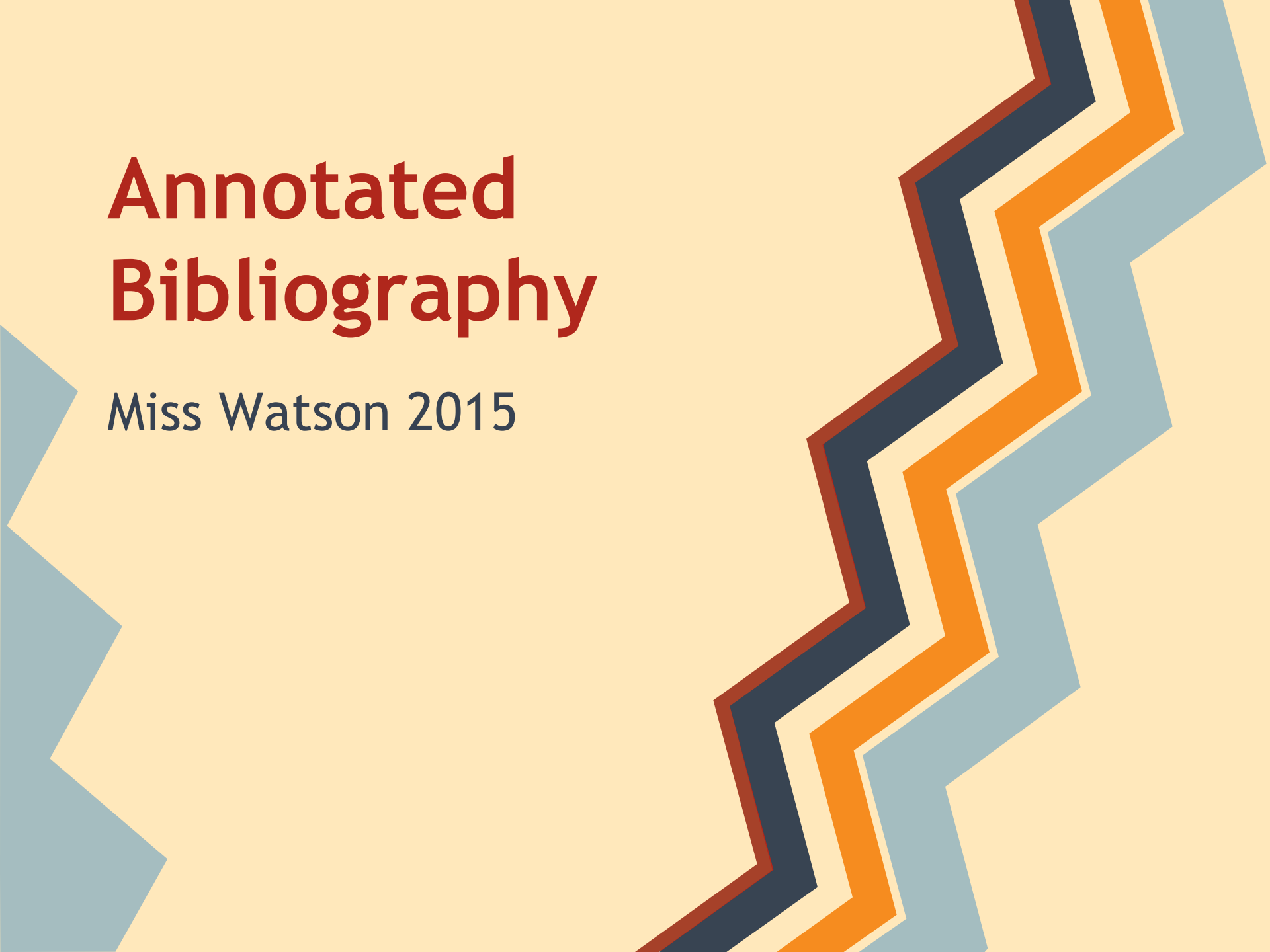

What is a Works Cited?

- List of formal citations (the resources used to research a topic)
- Citations formatted in *MLA*

What is an annotated Bibliography?

- Works Cited with a summary of each resource

Resource Summary

What should my resource summary include?

- Sentence 1 - What is the resource about?
- Sentence 2 - How is the resource reliable?
- Sentence 3 - Explain how the resource is related to the topic.
- Sentence 4 - Decide whether the resource is worth using for the written paper.
